### 2.4 Minutarum

Each clue consists of a time (associated to a specific event) which is modified by adding or subtracting another time (associated to a specific duration).

- Miss Havisham received her letter at twenty minutes to nine; the North Hollywood shoutout was 44 minutes long $\rightarrow 8: 40+0: 44=9: 24$
- In the Kipling poem, "the trees in the Shadow rustle and the trees in the moonlight glisten" at two o'clock in the morning; the John Cage masterpiece is $4^{\prime} 33^{\prime \prime}$, and 440 repetitions of it last 2002 minutes, or 33 hours and 22 minutes $\rightarrow 2: 00+33: 22=11: 22$
- In the Firewater song, the clouds are still bleeding at six forty-five; the gap on the Nixon tapes lasted 18 minutes $\rightarrow 6: 45+0: 18=7: 03$
- The Hiroshima bomb was dropped at 8:15 am; the Two Minutes of Hate lasts two mintes $\rightarrow 8: 15-0: 02=8: 13$
- The Magritte painting Time Transfixed shows a train emerging from a fireplace at 12:43; the XP installation issue is the 34 -minute hiccup $\rightarrow$ $12: 43-0: 34=12: 09$
- Will Kane and Frank Miller fight at High Noon; Gagarin's flight lasted $1: 48 \rightarrow 12: 00-1: 48=10: 12$

The resulting times, arranged in increasing order, are 7:03, 8:13, 9:24, 10:12, $11: 22,12: 09$. The hours are consecutive, while the minutes are all in the range 1 to 26 . Reading the minutes as letters gives CMXLVI, which is Roman numerals for the answer, 946.
